Resilient not just because we're strong, but because we grow better together.

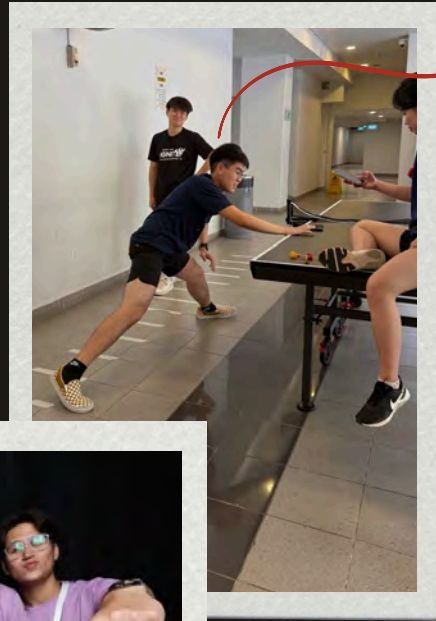

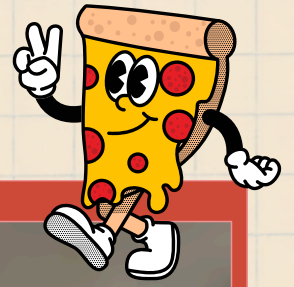
**Sandrina (RA)**

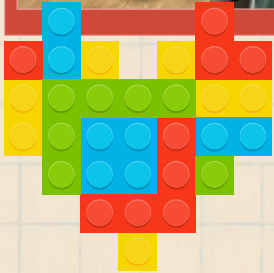
